## **Tri-County Electric Cooperative, Inc. OPSU Scholarship Application**

As part of Tri-County Electric's commitment to community, each year three high school seniors are granted a scholarship to Oklahoma Panhandle State University located in Goodwell, Okla. to help foster the development of effective leaders through continuing education opportunities.

To ensure you are qualified to apply for this scholarship, please read the requirements completely.

### **Scholarship Eligibility**

1. Applicant must be a graduating senior whose parents or legal guardians are active members of Tri-County Electric Cooperative.
2. Applicant should be in good standing with their school and should be actively involved with the school and community.
3. Members of the immediate families and/or persons residing in the households of cooperative trustees, management personnel, and/or employees of Tri-County Electric are not eligible to participate in the program or serve as winners.
4. Courses taken at OPSU must be credit toward a degree, certificate, diploma or license.

### **Making Application**

1. Each applicant shall submit a completed application along with a current photo. Applications may be obtained from Tri-County Electric or your high school counselor's office.
2. Entries must be received by **March 30, 2012**.
3. All applications must be typed or written legibly in ink.
4. All applications become property of Tri-County Electric Cooperative.
5. Mail the required application, current photo, transcript and all other supporting documents to Tri-County Electric Cooperative, PO Box 880, Hooker, OK 73945, Attn: Erin Moore

## **Selection of recipients**

1. An independent selection committee will consider each application on the basis of the following criteria:
  - a. Citizenship (community service, school involvement and participation)
  - b. Financial need
  - c. Academic achievement
2. Winners will be notified by letter.

## **Conditions**

1. If the winner of a Tri-County Electric scholarship learns that he or she is to receive a full scholarship from another source, the winner must notify Tri-County Electric and relinquish this scholarship, which will then be awarded to another student.
2. Once a scholarship has been awarded, monies cannot be transferred to another college.
3. If a recipient forfeits rights to a Tri-County Electric scholarship within the academic year of receipt, remaining funds will be payable to Tri-County Electric.
4. Payments will be made directly to OPSU at \$300 increments for each of four semesters through the sophomore year of college.
5. The student is responsible for sending a copy of their schedule to Tri-County Electric at the beginning of each semester in order for payment to be rendered to OPSU to verify enrollment.
